

Golf Guest Policy as of January 2025

Member Guests: Guests of any kind may not be included in, or assigned a starting time through, the draw before 12:30pm. Once the draw is made, remaining tee times are available for member play until three days following the draw (four days before day of play) when members may add guests for play in open tee times by calling the golf shop. Members may only have two groups of guests, 7 total, per tee time request. For example, whether going through the draw or by calling following three-day restriction, an individual member could book two times which would include the member and seven guests.

X'S: X's used in the draw will drop off 48 hours after the draw is made.

Time Reservation Abuse: Members may not use spouses' names, or another member who is not playing, to reserve a tee time, used as a placeholder to occupy a tee time and restrict other members from playing in the group or to take advantage of their point total. If members are found to be using this practice, the time will be cancelled by the golf shop staff and that member will be subject to all associated and cancelled fees, and disciplinary action, including suspension from all golf activities determined by management.

House Guests: Members must register house guests through the house guest registration link online via The Club's webpage. House guest identification cards will then be available for pickup at the reception window in the lobby of the main clubhouse. House guests tee times cannot be made until after 12:30pm. Two groups maximum per request. Your house guest must check in with the golf shop staff and identify themselves with their house guest card prior to play.

Pre-Booked Groups: To protect tee time availability for the general membership, it is not possible to prebook an outing with other members or guests in advance of the Draw, or more than fourteen days prior to play. This does not apply to pre-scheduled Food and Beverage Functions hosted within The Club for Members and their Guests.
