

## Food & Beverage Main Clubhouse & The Lodge Procedures for Reopening

The Main Clubhouse will open on Wednesday, May 6<sup>th</sup> and resume normal operating hours. Lunch is available 7 days a week and dinner is available Thursday - Saturday nights.

The Lodge will also open on Wednesday, May 6<sup>th</sup> and resume normal operating hours. Lunch is available Tuesday - Sunday, dinner is available Wednesday - Saturday nights.

Dinner hours will require a phone reservation only as online reservations will not be available during this first phase and to enable us to adhere to state guidelines – walk-in diners will not be able to be seated.

- Dining reservations will be taken by phone beginning at 12pm on Tuesday, May 5th. Online reservations will not be available.
- All reservations will be confirmed by a call back to the member. Reservations will be made based on first come, first served basis. Without confirmation, your reservation is not valid.
- Reservation requests left via voicemail are also not valid until a staff member has confirmed that reservation with you.

## Lunch dining will be based on a first-come, first-served basis in order to maintain occupancy restrictions and social distancing according to state guidelines.

The Ladies Card Room and Gents Poker Area will remain closed at this time.

The following precautions are being taken and stipulations put into place:

- All food and beverage staff will review SafeStaff training & best practices as from time to time provided by the Florida Restaurant and Lodging Association
- Employee screening for symptoms will occur daily and continue indefinitely
- Full curbside takeout will be available during business hours
- Outside dining is permitted with appropriate social distancing. Available tables and chairs may not be moved.
- In-house dining will operate under strict social distancing protocols:
  - $\circ$   $\,$  Occupancy must be limited to no more than 25% of capacity
  - o Appropriate social distancing requires a minimum of 6 feet between parties
  - Tables will be limited to a maximum of 6 people
  - Bar counters will be closed for seating
- Extra time will be allowed between reservations to allow cleaning and sanitizing all service items, menus, and any other items touched by members or staff.
- Groups of **TEN** are not permitted to congregate in **any space** that does not readily allow for appropriate social distancing

The Clubhouse staff will be strictly adhering to the guidelines put forth by the state for the safety of our staff and our members. We ask that you respect the efforts being made to bring Club dining back and appreciate your flexibility and understanding during Phase 1 of Florida's recovery plan.
